Kincora: Loudoun County, Virginia

Acted as Project Manager, assisting in design and overseeing preparation of all construction plans and profiles, and SWM plans for several facets of this large scale project. Kincora is a 424 acre mixed use development which includes 4 million square feet of office space, 500,000 square feet of retail, 1,400 condominiums and apartments, a fire station, as well as other various supported uses. Tasks included the design and construction administration of a four lane divided highway and internal roadway system, including dry utility design and coordination; and the layout of the multiple museum sites. Both Site Plans and various different zoning plans were processed as part of the extensive development.
